| Risk of spreading the virus if someone tests positive | All those who visit the venue. Risk of transmitting Covid-19 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -If someone who has played at the venue develops symptoms of COVID-19 (as outlined on the NHS website), they will be directed to follow the Government's 'test and trace' guidelines, which can be read on the Gov.uk website. -APTC bookings system ensures a record is kept of all those on the court. The coach is responsible for his sessions and holds similar records. Please note: It is the responsibility of Track and Trace to identify close contacts of a positive case but if guidelines are followed then it is unlikely that anyone else playing tennis would be identified as a close contact. | None | Med | Med | | |
