Thank you for joining us at Aston Park for the summer! We hope you enjoy the lovely courts, and have lots of fun playing tennis.

This is a relatively new type of membership offered by the club, but we hope it allows local families the chance to access the great facilities over the summer holidays at an affordable price. To ensure it is a success, and something we can do again, there are just a few things to bear in mind when you go...

- Please wear 'non-marking' footwear (particularly not the football type ridged trainers). If you are unsure if your shoes are suitable, take a look at this advice: http://www.ehow.com/how_12144025_check-shoe-nonmarking-soles.html.
- Our fence was very expensive, and so we ask you not to hit balls against it, as tempting as it is!
- We have tried to keep the cost nominal in the hope it encourages people to sign up with us, so we know who is accessing the courts for safety and insurance reasons. If you have friends who want to play with you or your children, can you ask them to sign up also (children who are in your care for the day ie. childminders, extended family members etc are welcome to go under your membership if they are coming under your responsibility). We just want to try and avoid the whole of the play park piling onto the courts at once!!
- Please can you to come with your children on court. Teenagers can come alone, but do remind them that friends have to have signed up too, and to lock up etc etc.

- Apart from Tuesday mornings, 10-12, when there is an adult club mix-in session, there are unlikely to be many adults playing matches when you are there. Even so, if there are adults there, you are still welcome to take a free court. As a club, we always try to be as welcoming to children playing on other courts as possible and realize balls do unintentionally fly in lots of directions! However, we would also like children to try and respect others playing on courts – so try not to run through their game (wait until a break in their match to go round the edge) and pick up all your balls and rackets when you have finished.
- The passcode for the gate lock (the entrance near the new houses) will be emailed to you when you join. Just put in the combination, and squeeze to unlock – it can be a little stiff. Hang the lock inside on the fence so if you are not last out, others can find it to lock up. It is sensible to close the gate behind you to avoid dogs looking for tennis balls. Please, please lock up when you leave – if others are still on court, politely say you are going and check they are ok to lock up.
- There is no access to the hut where the balls and rackets are stored. If you don't have your own, then give us a call and we can lend you some for the summer.
